## Enhancement of cyber educational system of Montenegro

The meeting was organized as part of the Conference InfoFest, held in hotel Maestral, Budva, Montenegro. A chairman of the meeting was Ramo Šendelj, the project representative of the host institution.

### 1. Welcome

On behalf of hosting institution, Ramo Šendelj welcomed the partners to the fifth ECESM consortium meeting and presented the ICT Conference InfoFest. The 21<sup>st</sup> InfoFest Conference is regional festival of ICT achievements and thus representing well-known ICT event at regional level. Ramo Šendelj suggested to all participants to continue with organizing ECESM conference about cyber security as integral part of the InfoFest Conference. In 2014 as the first project year, ECESM conference was organized as special session titled '*Critical information infrastructure in Montenegro*', while for the next year it shall be extended with more invited speakers and participants, due to expected progress of ECESM project.

Also, Matjaž Debevc as project leader welcomed all partners by expressing the great importance to participate at well-known regional ICT conference InfoFest, and agreed about further organizing of ECESM conference as integral part of InfoFest in Montenegro.

### 2. Recap/Overview of WP 1

Marko Holbl, leader of the Work package 1, presented the work done at WP1, which has been finalized and is ready for online publishing. Also, he presented results of reviews of deliverables 1.1, 1.2, 1.3 and 1.4, conducted by the Quality Control Board by emphasizing suggestions written by representatives from Global Cyber Security Center and Tallin University of Technology related to improvement of quality in deliverables 1.1, 1.2 and 1.3.

Corrections in accordance with those suggestions should be included in final version of deliverables and sent to WP leader, University of Maribor till 7<sup>th</sup> October. After finalizing the content, WP leader should work on technical improvements of deliverables and partner institution from UK, BUCKS University will be invited to make review of English language.

Deadline for publishing final version of all deliverables in WP1 is defined for 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2014.

#### ACTION 1

**All partners have to make revisions of their parts in deliverables 1.1, 1.2 and 1.3 in accordance with suggestions written by the Quality Control Board, until Tuesday, 7 October 2014 until 10 AM.**

**The WP1 leader, University of Maribor has to start with technical revision of deliverables in WP1 as soon as the revisions by other partners will be sent to them.**

### **3. Work progress and future work for WP2**

Ramo Šendelj, representative of National management board presented importance of WP2 for the whole project implementation and suggested for National Quality Board to actively participate in planning and organization of trainings.

In order to improve the quality and sustainable effects of upcoming trainings, the following activities are proposed:

- Making more frequent monitoring of trainings and periodical corrections if needed;
- Discussing about using surveys among business and governmental sector in order to provide realistic training needs in cyber security field;
- Discussing about possibility to certificate training participants and establish training standards for citizens related to cyber security

WP2 leader, BUCKS University should start with activities at 2.1 as soon as possible and distribute work over all planned institutions to participate. The plan of trainings should be completed and verified until next Consortium Meeting scheduled for 14<sup>th</sup> November in Tallinn, Estonia.

#### **ACTION 2**

**BUCKS University has to start with management activities over WP2 as soon as possible.**

**Project coordinator, University of Maribor, has to remind BUCKS University about responsibilities of being WP leader.**

**National Quality Board has to actively participate in WP2 activities, in particular during planning of trainings and their realization.**

### **4. General discussion**

Simon Hauptman informed all participants that the second part of financial installments is sent to all partners. More detailed presentation of financial management will be done during the next project consortium meeting in Tallinn, Estonia.

Also, Simon Hauptman reminded participants about continual reporting about organized dissemination activities.

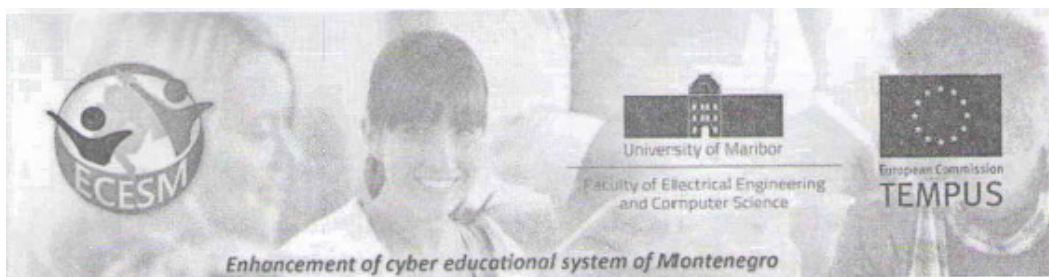
