Taxi service

Taxi fares are very high in Rome. There are fixed rates from the airports to anywhere in the city center (and the other way around):

Buses and Metro

There are only two lines of metro in Rome, but all the proposed accommodations and the meeting venue are pretty close to stops of metro line B. Metro B station “Marconi” is approximately 10 minutes walking from the venue.

Buses number 23 and 670 have the last station (in one of the two directions) right in front of the venue. Bus 23 is particularly useful, because it follows Via Ostiense, then Via Marmorata, and then goes on toward the city center and the Vatican City.
