- Official language is Montenegrin, while some articles can be also published on English. Authors from other language areas are also welcome to publish, while their articles must be translated on Montenegrin or English language.
- Editorial Board should be responsible for making selection of articles for publishing
- Editorial Board should be responsible to provide newsletter official registration in the National Library in Montenegro
