On Friday, 25th November 2016, Chamber of Economy Montenegro, together with partner institutions at ECESM project – Institute of modern technology Montenegro and University Donja Gorica organized a certificate ceremony.

Within the ECESM project, in the previous 9 months, 9 trainings were held, that resulted by 84 trainees successfully finished the training program. "In order to provide continuously education in the field of cyber security, Montenegrin Cyber Educational Centre (MCEC) has created, as the leader of informal educational activities at national level. CEM, together with MCEC, will be the hub of education of the business sector, through different types of trainings, workshops and providing consultancy services", said Rakocevic.

Professor at University Donja Gorica, PhD Ramo Sendelj, reminded the trainees about importance and necessity of continuous improvement of their knowledge in this area.
