The meeting was organized at premises of Global Cyber Security Center (GCSEC) in Rome, Italy. A chairman of the meeting was Massimo Cappelli, the project representative of the host institution.

1. Welcome

On behalf of hosting institution, Massimo Cappelli welcomed the partner representatives to the eighth ECESM consortium meeting. He presented the recent activities of GCSEC regarding cyber security, with the emphasis on NICE programme, developed within the institution at Poste Italiane.

2. Overview of actions from the previous meeting

Matjaž Debevc, University of Maribor, made an overview of the accepted actions at the previous Consortium meeting at BUCKS. Actions were carefully revised and discussed on. All of them have been successfully accomplished, therefore the meeting was able to continue as planned.

3. Final report regarding WP 2

Indrachapa Bandara, leader of the Work package 2, presented the final reports for the WP2, with finalized deliverables 2.1 and 2.2, 2.3 and 2.4, which are ready for online publishing.

4. WP3 work progress

Stefano Guarino, Roma TRE, provided a report on the progress and activities within Work Package 3. Representing the leading WP organization, he delegated the future work among the participants and provide instructions to them. The overall plan regarding the organization of future trainings was made. The consortium decided, based on the discussion with Montenegrin partners, to organize separate workshops for broader public (part of WP2) and professionals in organizations (WP3) working in the field of cyber security.

 - 2 days for professionals
- 7. Security Threats on the Web (UM)
 - 1 day for broader public
- 8. Access Control (UR3)
 - 1 day for professionals
- 9. Information Security Management (GCSEC)
 - 1 day for managers and authorities
 - 1 day for broader public

In the frame of WP 3.1 the proposed strategy is to firstly prepare the standards and secondly recognize the requirements for workshops.
