

SEMINAR REPORT

regarding "Security threats online - 2nd part"

Seminar called: "*Security threats online - 2nd part*" was held at the Chamber of Economy of Montenegro, on the 24th of May 2016, from 10AM to 3PM.

Prof. Dr. Marko Holbl, from the University of Maribor, Slovenia, was the lecturer during the seminar.

Seminar had 32 attendees.

The aim of the seminar was to raise awareness of the internet technology users regarding dangers which lurk within the cyber space and preventive means of operations which can be used.

At the end of the seminar there was a certain number of attendees (20) who completed a survey with the overall answers being numbers from 1 to 5. The following are the results stated as average scores:

1. Topic being current – 4,50
2. Expertise/ Competence of the lecturer – 4,75
3. Your previous knowledge regarding this subject – 3,75
4. Benefits of the acquired knowledge – 4,00
5. How much did the seminar meet the expectations of the attendees – 4,20

Survey, which in part was public, suggested that these types of seminars are necessary. Proposed topics of the seminars are:

- Incident security forensics
- Protection of personal information
- Information security risks management
- Implementation of ISO standards 27001
- VOIP

Conclusion and recommendations regarding preventive and corrective measures:

According to the survey results, questions which received maximum scores are those concerning *how current the topic was and the Expertise/ Competence of the lecturer*. Question of the *previous knowledge of attendees regarding this subject* received the lowest score. The average score of the Benefits of the acquired knowledge, given by the attendees was good.

Based on survey comments and recommendations it can be concluded that the education on this subject matter is much needed, that more of such education should be organized, with specific topics and practical examples.
