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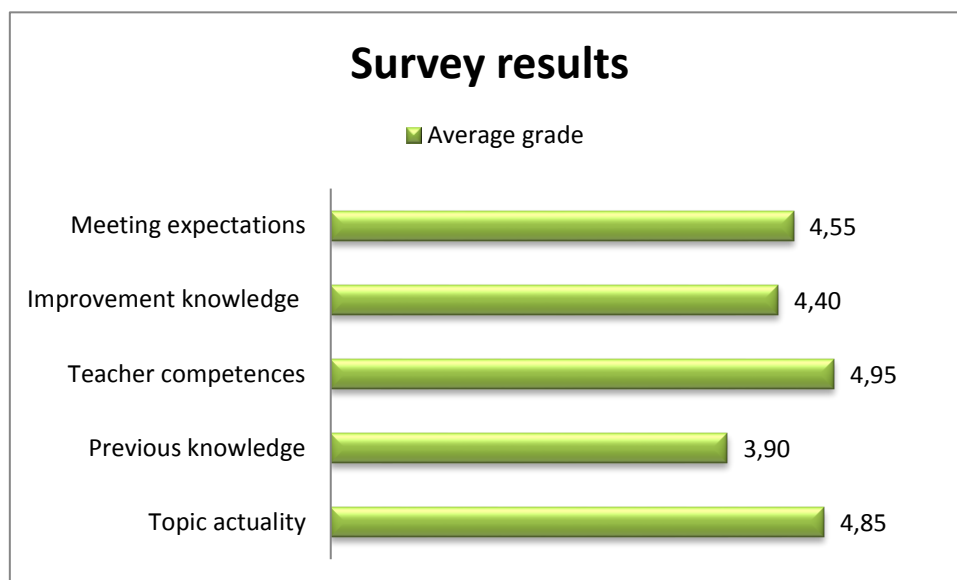
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Survey results

Participants completed surveys at the end of training, about topic actuality, their previous knowledge, teacher competences, gained new knowledge and meeting trainees' expectations. It was close-ended questions, on which the participants should evaluate each category from 1(bad) to 5(excellent).

The survey results are summarised in the following Graph:



Based on shown results in the Graph, we can see that max average grade has given to teacher competences and expertise, topic actuality and meeting participants' expectations. The min average grade has given to previous knowledge about the course topic.

One part of survey contented open-ended questions, related to critics, comments and suggestions. All written comments were about necessity of organisation of these training types. Also, as interesting topics for future trainings, the participants have suggested: Connection between ICT security and Law; Bank cards using; ICT impact on Montenegrin economy development and growth; Digital certificates; Cloud and virtual networks; and some workshops with possibility of practical work.
